IV. Open issues

1. Paving/Patching Roads: Paving is complete. Grant recertification for North side has been submitted. Town portion approximately \$37,000. Spoke with Engineer. We should know this month whether we were approved.

3. Clerk-Treasurer. Contact Rayann if you would like to take over. Submitted resignation to Henry County Clerk. Democratic Party is looking for someone to replace.

5. Dead End sign at S. High Street and E Main Street. Town will move the dead in sign up higher. Jason Clark has a "No Outlet" sign and Larry Adkins has post.
6. Ordinances. Still working on. Hopeful to have them done prior next meeting.



10. Snow plow Bids. Jason Manning and Austin Back submitted bids. Board reviewed and voted Manning Lawn Care for this year's snow plowing. \$150 per push, plus \$25 an hour.
11. Guy Showalter. Alleyway 120 S High and 130 S High. Indicted he would spread it when the ground is harder.
12. Olivia Neal Negligence regarding Mike Dawson's dog attacking cat. Research was done prior to a decision being made. Decision was made that Mike Dawson's would receive a first offense for the Dick's cat, which is a verbal warning. Mike Dawson received a second offense for Neal's cat, which was a written warning. Matter closed.


